N of Morgans Point: Fog is expected to become increasingly isolated through 10 timeframe with a few instances of visibilities of less than 1 mile during this time. Fog free conditions are expected for much of the PM.


S of Morgans Point: From 10 AM to 1 PM fog is expected to gradually wane with instances of 1 mile or less visibility becoming increasingly isolated during this time. Expect improving conditions late AM into the PM. Fog free conditions are expected thereafter for much of the PM.



N of Morgans Point: Fog is expected to expand around 2 – 3 AM WED becoming increasingly widespread through the early AM. Fog can linger through about 9 – 10 AM before the fog dissipates here. Into early WED AM visibilities of less than 1 mile will be possible.

S of Morgans Point: Isolated fog will be possible around 10 PM TUE before becoming more widespread/ expanding in coverage in the 2 – 4 AM timeframe WED. Widespread fog will be likely at least through 10 AM. From 10 am to 1 PM, fog is anticipated to become increasingly isolated. However, lower confidence as to how long fog can linger late WED AM into WED PM into the area. At times, especially through 10 AM, visibilities of less than 1 mile will be likely with increasingly isolated instances through 1 PM.



Precip: Dry conditions favored for today, however a brief, isolated, light shower between 10 AM – 3 PM cannot be ruled out.

Wind: Winds turning from out of the SSE to out of the SW from 12 AM – 10 AM, remaining this direction through the day. **N of Morgan's Point:** Winds of 6 – 11 kts through the day. Gusts of **18 – 21 kts** from 10 AM – 1 PM. **S of Morgan's Point:** Winds of 6 – 11 kts through 3 PM, increasing slightly to 11 – 16 kts through 8 PM before calming back to 5 – 10 kts. **A few gusts up to 20 kts from 3 AM – 6 AM, and gusts of 18 – 21 kts from 11 AM – 7 PM.**

High Temps: **N of Morgan's Point:** Low 80s F. **S of Morgan's Point:** Mid 70s F.



Forecast Discussion


Precip: Dry conditions remain favored for Wednesday, however a brief, light, isolated shower remains possible after 1 PM, with "best chances" after 6 PM.

Wind: Winds out of the SW through 11 AM, turning to out of the SE thereafter.
N of Morgan's Point: Winds of 3 – 8 kts through 3 PM, increasing slightly to 7 – 12 kts thereafter. **A few gusts to 20 kts after 3 PM.** **S of Morgan's Point:** Winds of 4 – 9 kts through 2 PM, increasing to 8 – 13 kts through 9 PM, and again to 12 – 17 kts thereafter. **A few gusts to 20 kts after 2 PM.** **A few gusts to 25 kts at the Boarding Station after 9 PM.**



High Temps: **N of Morgan's Point:** Low 80s F. **S of Morgan's Point:** Mid 70s F.

Forecast Discussion



Precip: A few light, brief, isolated showers from 12 AM – 9 AM, increasing in coverage from 9 AM through the remainder of the day. A washout is NOT anticipated, but on-and-off shower activity is favored. 12 PM – 6 PM will be the optimal time frame.

Wind: Winds out of the S through the day. **N of Morgan's Point:** Winds of 8 – 13 kts through 10 AM, increasing to 13 – 18 kts through 5 PM, and falling to 7 – 12 kts thereafter. **Gusts of 18 – 23 kts through 10 AM, 28 – 33 kts through 5 PM, and 15 – 20 kts thereafter.** **S of Morgan's Point:** Winds of 12 – 17 kts through 9 AM (15 – 20 kts at the **Boarding Station**), slightly increasing to 15 – 20 kts through 5 PM before falling back to 8 – 13 kts through evening. **Gusts of 20 – 25 kts through 4 PM, and 15 – 20 kts thereafter.**


High Temps: **N of Morgan's Point:** Low 80s F. **S of Morgan's Point:** Low 70s F.







Precip Image: 12 PM CT

- Above/much above normal temps are favored over the next 7 days, with minimal / isolated rain chances over the next 7 days.
- Slightly below-normal temperatures and slightly below normal rainfall favored in the Week 2 timeframe.
- Near normal temperatures and near normal rainfall expected for mid/late January.
