

- Fog will work in for **ALL STATIONS** through 9 AM tomorrow, with pockets lingering in the bay through 6 PM before more widespread fog returns.









Patchy fog will begin to become possible for **ALL STATIONS** after 9 PM CST, lasting through 9 AM. Pockets of visibilities of <0.5 miles will be in play.

Stations **N of Morgan's Point** are anticipated to clear after 9 AM, while **stations in the Bay** can see a few localized pockets of fog with visibilities dropping to 1 mile through 6 PM before more widespread fog and visibilities <1 mile can work back into the bay THU evening. Fog can respread **N of Morgan's Point** after 9 PM THU evening.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: A few heavier showers and thunderstorms in play through 6 PM. No severe risks anticipated. Hit/miss pockets of drizzle will remain in play after 6 PM.

Wind: Winds out of the SE for the entire day. **N of Morgan's Point:** Winds of 3 – 8 kts through the rest of the day. **S of Morgan's Point:** Winds of 7 – 12 kts through the rest of the day, with winds up to 15 kts possible at the **Boarding Station**. **Sporadic gusts to 20 kts for ALL Stations through the day.**



Visibility: Patchy fog / drizzle risks start S of Morgan's Point after 6PM.



Forecast Discussion



Precip: A few lingering light showers through 9 AM.

Wind: Winds to be variable and light throughout the day. **N of Morgan's Point:** Winds of 3 – 8 kts through the day. **S of Morgan's Point:** Winds of 5 – 10 kts. Negligible gusts.


High Temps: **N of Morgan's Point:** Low 70s F. **S of Morgan's Point:** Mid 60s F.

Visibility: Fog likely for ALL Stations from 3AM – 10AM before burning off through 2PM. See visibility slide for additional details.

Sea Fog risks will also increase once again after 9PM on Thursday.

Forecast Discussion

Precip: Favoring dry conditions through 4PM, with scattered downpours possible through 8PM before exiting the area (boarding station with best risk).

Wind: Winds out of the ESE through the entire day.

Point: Winds of 3 - 8 kts through the day.

Morgan's Point: Winds of 4 - 9 kts through the day.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Upper 60s F / Lower 70s F.

S of Morgan's Point: Low 60s F.


Visibility: Sea fog risks will be in play for all stations through 10AM.
