
Boarding Station: Patchy dense fog continues through 12 PM FRI, breaking up in coverage from 12 PM – 6 PM. Isolated pockets cannot be ruled out entirely in the vicinity of the station.

S of Morgan's Point: Patchy dense fog continues through 12 PM FRI, breaking up in coverage from 12 PM – 6 PM. Coverage is expected to break up in the afternoon, but likely remain greater than at the Boarding Station. While fog can linger after 6 PM, any showers will quickly dissipate any pockets.


N of Morgan's Point: Dense fog likely to dissipate after by 12 PM.



Isolated pockets of dense fog will remain in play from 12 AM through 9 AM Saturday morning. A few pockets of visibilities falling to 1 mile will be in play, however any isolated pockets of showers will quickly dissipate pockets of fog.

Heavy rain moving in at 9 AM is anticipated to eliminate fog for ALL Stations.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: A few light, brief, isolated showers through the day on Saturday, with the likeliest time after 6 PM.

Wind: Winds primarily out of the E through the day. **N of Morgan's Point:** Winds of 5 – 10 kts through the day.. **S of Morgan's Point:** Winds of 5 – 10 kts through 12 PM, increasing slightly to 8 – 13 kts through 9 PM and up to 12 – 17 kts through midnight. Winds at the **Boarding Station** of 12 – 17 kts from 12 PM – 5 PM, and 16 – 21 kts thereafter. **Gusts to 20 kts S of Morgan's Point from 6 AM – 12 PM, 20 – 25 kts through 6 PM, and 23 – 28 kts for ALL Stations thereafter.** Gusts at the Boarding Station of can reach 33 kts from 6 PM – 12 AM.



High Temps: **N of Morgan's Point:** Mid 60s F. **S of Morgan's Point:** Low 60s F.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Light showers from 12 AM through 9 AM, with heavier rain and a couple lightning strikes from 9 AM – 12 PM. Light showers lingering through the day afterwards.

Wind: Winds out of the E though 11 AM, turning to out of the N thereafter. **N of Morgan's Point:** Winds of 10 – 15 kts through the day. **Gusts of 23 – 28 kts through 10 AM, lowering to 20 kts thereafter.** **S of Morgan's Point:** Winds of 15 – 20 kts through the day. **Gusts of 30 – 35 kts 4 AM – 12 PM, and 18 – 23 kts afterwards.** **Boarding Station:** Winds of 20 – 25 kts through the day. **Gusts of 30 – 35 kts from 12 AM – 8 AM, and 35 – 40 kts through 11 AM. 22 – 27 kt gusts thereafter.**



High Temps: **N of Morgan's Point:** Upper 50s F. **S of Morgan's Point:** Upper 50s F.

Visibility: Isolated pockets of fog in play until heavy rain arrives as 9 AM for ALL Stations.

Forecast Discussion



Precip: Light showers continue through 6 AM, with another round of storms from 6 - 9 AM. While not favored, we will need to watch for a brief window of light freezing rain behind AM storms.

Wind: Winds out of the NW through the day. **N of Morgan's Point:** Winds of 8 - 13 kts through the day. **Gusts of 20 - 25 kts through the day.** **S of Morgan's Point:** Winds of 15 - 20 kts through 5 AM, increasing to 22 - 27 kts through 1 PM and 18 - 23 kts thereafter. **Gusts of 30 - 35 kts through the day, briefly lower at 25 - 30 kts from 12 - 6 PM.** Winds at the **Boarding Station** of 25 - 30 kts through 6 AM, and 22 - 27 kts thereafter. **Gusts of 33 - 38 kts through the day.**


High Temps: **N of Morgan's Point:** Mid 30s F. **S of Morgan's Point:** Low 40s F.

Visibility: While fog potential remains at least possible, persistent rainfall will likely act to strongly reduce coverage / timespan of any pockets.









Precip Image: 6 AM CT
