
**Stations N of Morgan's Point:** Patchy fog will be possible through 9AM. Visibilities of less than 2 miles will be in play, but confidence is lower in coverage and timing due to poor winds.

**Stations S of Morgan's Point:** Isolated sea fog is expected to linger in the bay through 11AM, with residual isolated pockets of mist possible through 2PM. Visibilities of less than 1 mile to be in play. 4AM – 9AM will be the period we are watching for the most widespread sea fog, although confidence is lower due to less favorable winds.


**Boarding Station & 11/12:** Anticipating widespread sea fog with visibilities of less than 1 mile to be in play from through 2PM. Sea fog to likely become more isolated beyond 2PM MON, however confidence is lower in how long fog can linger into the evening.



**Stations N of Morgan's Point:** Isolated pockets of fog are anticipated from 6 PM MON to 9 AM TUE. Visibilities <1 mile possible, though pockets of fog are expected to be brief.

**Stations S of Morgan's Point & N of 11/12:** Isolated fog is anticipated from 2 – 11 PM MON before becoming patchy in nature from 11 PM MON to 9 AM TUE. Visibilities of <1 mile possible.

**11/12 & The Boarding Station:** Patchy to widespread sea fog will be possible from 2 PM MON to 12 AM TUE, with isolated pockets then possible through 9 AM TUE. Visibilities <1 mile in play.




**Wind:** Winds out of the S through the entire day.

**Wind:** Winds will be out of the SW through 2 AM before becoming variable. Winds then settle out of the SE after 10 AM.


**N of Morgan's Point:** Winds of 1 – 6 kts through the day.

**High Temps:** **N of Morgan's Point:** High 70s F. **S of Morgan's Point:** High 60s F.


