

- Rain and storm chances Saturday afternoon/evening. We will need to watch for a stronger storm or two.







**Stations S of Morgan's Point:** Isolated pockets of dense fog will be possible through 12AM, prior to the arrival of rain. Fog is not anticipated beyond 12AM, which is a change to our previous forecast of 1AM - 7AM. Visibilities will be reduced below 1 mile.

## Forecast Discussion




**Precip:** Favoring dry conditions the rest of the day.

**Wind:** Winds out of the S/SW for the rest of the day. **N of Morgan's Point:** Winds of 5 – 10 kts. **S of Morgan's Point:** Winds of 6 – 11 kts.

**Low Temps:** **N of Morgan's Point:** Low 60s F. **S of Morgan's Point:** Near 60 F.

**Visibility:** Isolated fog will be possible through 12AM and not anticipating fog to occur beyond 12AM Wednesday.

## Forecast Discussion


**Precip:** Scattered light showers possible through 5PM. More dry time than not is favored.

**Wind:** Winds will start the day out of the S/SW, becoming variable in direction after 6AM with the tendency to blow out of the N. **N of Morgan's Point:** Winds of 2 – 7 kts through the day. **S of Morgan's Point:** Winds of 2 – 7 kts.


**High Temps:** **N of Morgan's Point:** High 70s F. **S of Morgan's Point:** High 60s / near 70 F.

**Visibility:** Clouds and rain are expected to linger through the morning hours and eliminate fog potential.



## Forecast Discussion


**Precip:** Dry conditions favored Thursday.

**Wind:** Winds will be out of the N, shifting clockwise from 3AM - 12PM and settling out of the SE. **N of Morgan's Point:** Winds of 2 - 7 kts. **S of Morgan's Point:** Winds of 5 - 10 kts.


**High Temps:** **N of Morgan's Point:** Mid 70s F. **S of Morgan's Point:** Mid to Upper 60s F.

**Visibility:** Fog is possible throughout the day Thursday, with the better risk for sea fog S of Morgan's Point in the afternoon hours.






## Next 7 Day Temperature Departure




## Next 7 Day Total Precipitation



## 8-14 Day Temperature Departure




### 8-14 Day % of Average Precip.




