

- Strong to severe storms will be likely SAT evening.








CURRENT VISIBILITY (2:30 AM CT)


Boarding Station to Station 25/26: Fog with visibilities <1 mile will continue to impact these Stations through 12PM. A lack of winds will keep intermittent breaks in the dense fog a possibility and improve visibilities temporarily to 1-3 miles at times through the AM.

Station 37/38 to Morgan's Point: Patchy to widespread dense fog will be possible through 10AM before burning off. Visibilities of less than 1 mile will be possible.


Stations N of Morgan's Point: Patchy sea fog will remain through at least 9AM before visibilities return to above 2 miles. Confidence lowest in coverage and duration for these stations.

Boarding Station to Station 11/12: Patchy fog will be able to linger through 5PM, but confidence is lowest in this period. Regardless, fog is anticipated to become less dense. Visibilities of 1 – 2 miles possible. Coverage of fog will build once again after 5PM, continuing into the evening/SAT AM. Visibilities to drop to <1 mile with widespread concerns favored.

Stations N of 11/12 (including Morgan's Point): From 6PM – 11PM, patchy fog is favored to work back over these stations. Winds will be slightly higher than previous nights and from a more favorable direction. We are leaning towards a more widespread risk through ~9AM SAT, with visibilities of less than 2 miles likely. Drizzle chances can work in early SAT AM which can end this risk earlier. Confidence is low.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Light, isolated showers will be possible between 5PM – 9PM Friday. Most activity is favored to stay N and W of Stations.

Wind: Winds will be generally out of the S/SE. **N of Morgan's Point:** Winds of 3 – 8 kts. **S of Morgan's Point:** Winds of 3 – 8 kts, increasing to 6 – 11 kts after 4PM through the rest of the evening.


High Temps: N of Morgan's Point: Mid 70s F. **S of Morgan's Point:** Mid to upper 60s F.

Visibility: Widespread fog in the AM will lead to more isolated fog in the afternoon with fog building once again into the evening.


Precip Image: 7 PM CT

Forecast Discussion



Precip: Isolated showers possible from 6AM – 2PM. Scattered storms are then expected from 6PM – 11PM. **A few strong to severe storms will be expected with wind gusts of 40+ kts, small hail and heavy downpours, mainly from 9PM – 11PM.**

Wind: Winds out of the S/SE. **N of Morgan's Point:** Winds of 2 – 8 kts through 10AM, increasing to 9 – 14 kts thereafter. **S of Morgan's Point:** Winds of 10 – 15 kts through 10AM, increasing to 16 – 22 kts thereafter. **Wind gusts of 25 – 30 kts possible for all Stations throughout the day. Non-thunderstorm gusts up to 35 kts possible from 7 - 11PM for all Stations.**


High Temps: **N of Morgan's Point:** Mid 70s F. **S of Morgan's Point:** Mid to upper 60s.

Visibility: Fog will be possible through ~9AM although confidence is lower than normal on this threat. This will conclude the extended sea fog threat.

Forecast Discussion


Precip: Isolated showers through 2AM favored before dry conditions are favored for the remainder of the day.

Wind: Winds will be out of the W through 3AM before slowly turning to out of the NW from 3AM – 9AM. Winds will remain out of the N/NW for the remainder of the day. **N of Morgan's Point:** Winds of 7 – 11 kts through 12PM before weakening to 3 – 8 kts. **S of Morgan's Point:** Winds of 8 – 13 kts through 2PM before weakening to 5– 10 kts thereafter.


High Temps: **N of Morgan's Point:** Low 70s F. **S of Morgan's Point:** Upper 50s to mid 60s F.

Visibility: No fog risks are favored.







Next 7 Day Temperature Departure




8-14 Day Temperature Departure




15-30 Day Temperature Departure


Week 3/4 Temperature Outlook




Next 7 Day Total Precipitation

- Above normal temps are favored over the next 7 days, with scattered storms/downpours possible over the weekend.
- Much above normal temperatures and below normal rain chances in the Week 2 period.
- Much above normal temperatures and below normal rainfall expected for late February and the start of March.
